Vidigueira -Tourist attractions (*):



Ruins of São Cucufate (6 km from our estate):

Part of the story of these Roman ruins, is linked to the village of Vila de Frades. This village was established in the parish of São Cucufate, in 1255. It belonged to the Monastery of São Vicente de Fora in Lisbon, who received a donation of the buildings and surroundings of this ancient Roman villa from King Afonso III.



Hermitages: The ancient chapels on the surrounding hills, remain a testimony of the population's faith of God and of the Catholic Church. The passing of time has led to the abandonment of these chapels, which have a privileged view over the surrounding valleys and plains. In Vidigueira you may visit several: The Hermitages of Santa Clara, São Rafael, Santo

Antonio, Santa Luzia and São Pedro.



Churches: It's easy to find a church almost around every corner in the municipality. The Church of Misericórdia in Vidigueira is one of the oldest churches in the entire country. It goes back to the time of Queen Leonor who officially established the Misericórdia of Lisbon (charity). The other churches may not be so ancient, but nevertheless gave their contribution to the history of the region.



Tower / Keep: From what was once a stately building, today the former residence of the Counts of Vidigueira is limited to this single tower. In the western zone of the village, you can find olive groves and vineyards that spread towards the Hermitage of Santa Clara and Vila de Frades.



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The Clock Tower: The bell tower has an interesting story as this was a gift from Navigator, Vasco da Gama to the people of Vidigueira. It's situated in a narrow and curved road in the middle of the village.

Tourist attractions near Vidigueira:

The Alqueva Dam - 20 km from our estate (the largest artificial lake in Europe*)



The Dam has a reservoir spreading over 250km² and more than 1100kms of shore line and it is the largest artificial lake in Europe. It covers 5 municipalities in the Alentejo: Portel, Moura, Reguengos de Monsaraz, Mourão and Alandroal as well as the Spanish municipalities of Olivença (not recognized by Portugal as Spanish territory), Cheles, Alconchel and Villanueva del Fresno. The Dam caters for a variety of tourist activities: House-boats, cruises, balloon or helicopter flights, birdwatching, hunting, sailing, water skiing, fishing, horse riding, etc.

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
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City of Évora (50km north Vidigueira)

Évora comes from the original name Eborá from the Celts and is one of the most beautiful historical cities in the world. The Romans built a glorious temple in honour of the Emperor Augustus. Later on, the Portuguese nobility constructed stately palaces, chapels, convents and majestic gothic cathedrals. Traces from different epochs and civilizations remain practically intact, in a city where people walk on medieval cobbled roads. You can step through broad arcades on to picturesque piazzas, with modern boutiques and craft shops. The coffee shops with terraces invite you to relax, while the bars and restaurants offer a representative gastronomic delight of southern Alentejo.

City of Beja (20km south Vidigueira):

Beja, the district's capital with the same name, is also the headquarters of one of the largest municipalities of Portugal. It's believed that the city was founded in 400 B.C. by the Celts. For several times the name of this City has been changed, from Pax Julia (so called by the Romans) to Paca and in VIII Century adopting the name of Beja, when it was dominated by the Arabs. Prince Al-Mutamid "the renowned King-Poet" dedicated most of his work to the love of young maidens and boys. Beja received its foral/charter in 1524 by the Portuguese king and became a city in 1517.
